Dear Friends

Over the last week or so, I've been meeting with each of our PCCs in turn to consider whether we could safely return to our buildings for Easter Sunday – and onwards.

In considering this, we have borne three key factors in mind:

- 1. the proportion of our congregations who will have received two vaccines by Easter Sunday;
- 2. the local infection rate;

3. a request from the County Council that places of worship stay closed for the time being; a request linked to the local infection rate.

Weighing up each of these factors, every PCC in the Flagstaff Family has decided that our buildings must remain closed for Easter.

I know that some of us will find being out of our buildings for the second Easter in a row very tough, but you will understand that we have made this decision to protect the most vulnerable, and to play our part in the regional effort to drive down infection rates, which remain above the national average.

In the meantime, although our buildings are closed, our church communities are very much 'open', as you can see from the list of services and activities we have planned for you. I think it will be a very special Holy Week and Easter, and I look forward to journeying through it with you.

Looking further ahead, St Helen's PCC has agreed to re-open for in-building services once our local area moves to Stage 2 of the government road map; that is on or after 12 April (the same stage that non-essential retail and hairdressers and so on reopen). When we do return to our buildings, we will continue to be live-stream our worship for those who are unable to join us in the buildings for whatever reason.

May God bless you and grant you a Holy Week.
