# Notices for 9<sup>th</sup> May 2021

A question all curates who are coming towards the end of their first 3 years of ordained ministry are often asked is: "Do you know where you are going?" It's a good question, and certainly one which I think can have wider implications, firstly as individuals in our faith: Where are we going? As a local church, family of churches, diocese, national church and wider Anglican Communion: Where are we going?

Then in the afternoon St Mary's Coleorton will reopen for those who can make that journey to the building. We may make small steps, but small steps are what makes a journey.

Of course, like the disciples on the road to Emmaus discovered, we do not journey alone, the Risen Christ has promised to never leave us or forsake us, my goodness isn't this such a relief to remember and keep remembering, Jesus is with us, so wherever we are going, we do not go alone.
