### Dear Friends

This coming week, remember young people, their families and their teachers in your prayers.

It will be a big week: on Tuesday, A level results are released, and on Thursday, GCSE results will be shared with students.

These grades have been teacherassessed and then moderated by Ofqual – so there is extra pressure on teachers, who will feel under scrutiny for their decision-making, and extra stress on students, who haven't been able to sit exams.

Pray for those who will be delighted and excited; who have met or surpassed their expectations and whose plans for next year can proceed uninhibited.

Pray for those who will be disappointed, devastated even; who haven't been awarded what they hoped for or felt they deserved and whose plans for next year will be scuppered.

Pray, too, for those who don't have plans for next year; who have been so dislocated by the pandemic that they simply don't know what is, or should be, next.

Pray for teachers, who have worked so hard during the pandemic to support their students but who, all too often, have not been given credit for their efforts or, worse, have been castigated in the press.

And pray for parents who, through all the highs and loves, seek to support

their children and to encourage them. Pray for them when their own resources are at an end, but they have to find a way to keep going.

And, finally, pray for the press: for even-handed reporting; for giving credit where it is due; for challenging in responsible ways; for considering the vulnerable who might be most effected by what they write.
