COVID RISK ASSESSMENTS

Following the Government's relaxation of Covid-19 restrictions on 27th January, wearing of masks is no longer mandatory in indoor settings. This was discussed by St Helen's PCC on 15th February and it was concluded that people should be free to make their own decisions about wearing masks in church. We continue to encourage people to take a lateral flow test prior to attending church. We are reserving both the side aisle in front of St Michael's Chapel and some pews at the back of church on the right hand side as being only for those wearing masks and who do not want to be close to people who are unmasked.

The Wardens and PCC will keep our Covid policies as a standing item on the PCC agenda and under regular review in the light of Government and Church of England guidance and recommendations, implementing them in ways that seem most appropriate to our congregation.

AN EVENING OF SONG WITH OFF THE RECORD - REARRANGED

After the cancellation of their concert on Friday 18th February because of Storm Eunice, we are pleased that Off the Record have been able to rearrange to be with us on Friday 18th February at 7pm.
