Parish Giving Scheme

Hopefully many of you will have read Cornelia Wright's article in September's Parish Magazine about the Parish Giving Scheme – if not, September's issue remains available on-line and this is a brief summary of the longer article.

The Parish Giving Scheme [PGS] is a means of giving regularly to the church, it is very straightforward to sign up and you have just as much control over your donations as for Direct Debits or Standing Orders. You can choose to increase your giving annually in line with inflation, but you can opt in or out of this at any time. One benefit to the church is markedly reduces administration in claiming Gift Aid; instead of us having to submit a manual claim for Gift Aid, it is claimed by the PGS on our behalf, so that we receive it automatically.

We are enormously grateful to those who have recently signed up to the PGS – regular giving enables us to make responsible financial decisions for the life and ministry of our church.
